### **Encounter History at *The Lost Colony***

– *Outdoor drama brings life to historic North Carolina events* –

(Manteo, N.C., July 17, 2008) – In July of 1584, an expedition dispatched by Sir Walter Raleigh and Queen Elizabeth I landed on what is now the Outer Banks of North Carolina. Phillip Amadas and Arthur Barlowe with the pilot Simon Fernandez were part of this expedition. According to Barlowe's narrative, they then took formal possession of
